Be it Remembered That at a District Court of the

United States of America, held in and for the Eastern District of New York, on
the twenty-ninth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine
hundred and four Arthur Riley at present of
the Borough of Brooklyn City and State of New York, having appeared in said Court and
applied to be admitted a Citizen of the United States of America, pursuant to the directions
of the Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled: "An Act to establish a uniform rule
of Naturalization, etc.," passed April 14th, 1802, and Acts subsequently passed on that subject, and to the
directions of the Act of Congress entitled "An Act To regulate the immigration of aliens into the United States,"
approved March 3rd, 1903, and having thereupon produced to the Court such evidence, and made such
declaration, renunciation and affidavits as are by the said Acts required, and the same having been duly recorded as
provided by said Acts, it was Thereupon Ordered by the said Court that he be admitted, and he was ac-
cordingly admitted to be a Citizen of the United States of America.
